HOURS OF OPERATION: Wednesday & Saturday 8 AM - 4 PM / Sunday 12 Noon - 4 PM.

HOW TO OBTAIN PERMITS / PUNCHCARDS: Permits and punchcards may be obtained at the <u>Tax Office located at 8 Park Place in Vernon</u>. Permits must be purchased annually and are good for the fiscal year July 1-June 30. **Punchcards do not expire.** Vehicle registration and a driver's license must be shown.

MATTRESSES/BOXSPRINGS: Disposal of mattresses and boxsprings, regardless of size, will require an additional punch each on the punchcard at the Transfer Station.



When purchasing a new mattress and/or boxspring, residents should consider arranging for disposal of the old ones.

FREON UNITS: (Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers) Disposal costs dictate an additional fee be charged. To avoid handling cash at the Transfer Station, cards will receive 3 punches per freon unit.



Plan ahead! Do you have enough punches available on your punchcard

to dispose of a freon unit, a mattress or a boxspring?

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS FOR DISPOSAL

Brush - Any size branch, no stumps allowed.

Oversized Bulky Items - Sleep sofas, recliners, building materials (asphalt shingles in small quantities only)

Metals - Grills, bikes, swing sets, lawn mowers, propane tanks (empty-30 lb. max), miscellaneous scrap

Appliances - Freon units, stoves, washers, dryers, microwaves, dishwashers, fans, etc.

Waste Motor Oil & Antifreeze - Put oil and antifreeze into clean plastic Container such as clean laundry detergent container with a screw-on cap. Label container. Do not mix oil and antifreeze. Leave container at designated area at Transfer Station. 5 gallon max per visit.



Tires - unmounted or mounted

METAL - Items that are at least 75% metal will now be accepted at the Transfer Station free of charge. Does not include freon units (refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, and air conditioners. Items such as sleeper sofas or recliners that have only a small amount of metal are now considered bulky items. A permit & punchcard are required to dispose of bulky items.

PERMIT & PUNCHCARD NOT REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

Excess Refuse & Recycling

Metal - Does not include freon units (refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, and air conditioners.)

Electronics Recycling

Yard Waste - Two bundles of brush and one trash bag filled with weeds, tree trimmings, pine cones, pine needles, etc. will be accepted.

Single Burnable Item Drop-off Dates (4 times per year)

Waste Motor Oil & Antifreeze - Put oil and antifreeze into a clean plastic container such as a clean laundry detergent container with a screw-on cap. Label container. Do not mix oil and antifreeze. Leave container at designated area at Transfer Station. (5-gal max per visit)

Lead acid batteries

Mulch (Seasonal) - Free to Vernon residents (proof of residency required). Residents are responsible for loading their own mulch.

Paper (shredded or unshredded) - Large amounts will be accepted at the Transfer Station. Place SHREDDED paper in a brown paper grocery bag and staple it closed.

Books/DVDs/VHS tapes & cassettes - Collection container is available at the Transfer Station. Place books in a cardboard box with lid so that boxes may be stacked within the container.

Fluorescent Lightbulbs - Tubes and household compact fluorescent lightbulbs.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

No hazardous waste

No grass, leaves or stumps

No commercial vehicles, contractors or businesses allowed

No vehicles with dump bodies allowed
