Board of Assessment Appeals (BAA):

The Board of Assessment Appeals members meet twice a year to hear appeals for Real Estate, Personal Property and Motors Vehicles. Applications are available in the Assessor's Office or online.

Hearings for Real Estate, Personal Property and Supplemental Motor Vehicles are held in the month of March each year. Applications are to be filed in the Assessor's Office no later than February 20th. No walk-ins will be heard. Applications are available by January 10th. If there is an extension for filing the Grand List, these dates are moved to the next month.

Hearings for Motor Vehicles are held in September each year. September hearings are held on a first-come, first-served basis. Applications are available in the office or on our website (www.vernon-ct.gov).

You need to bring an application and motor vehicle with you to the hearing, or fill one out once you arrive.

Schedules are published in the *Journal Inquirer* three weeks prior to the hearings and are also posted in the Assessor's and Town Clerk's Offices. Anyone aggrieved with the results of the hearing may file suit in Superior Court within sixty days of the results. For more information, contact the Assessor's Office main phone number (860) 870-3625.
