PUBLIC HEARING:

Mayor Ellen L. Marmer, M.D., called the Public Hearing to order at 7:12 p.m. to receive and hear comments regarding the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Budget of the Town of Vernon.

The Clerk read the Legal Notice and certified that the legal notice was posted on March 15, 2007 on the Town Hall bulletin board and published in the Journal Inquirer on March 16, 2007.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Robert Hurd, 7 Rheel Street, President Board of Trustees Rockville Library, spoke in favor of the library budget and felt the Town should "preserve the partnership".

Robert Dickerman, 42 Eva Circle, requested copies of the budget for citizens of the Town. The Mayor stated that the budget summaries would be available in the Town Clerk's office by March 28th and would also be placed at the library and in the Senior Center. Mr. Dickerman questioned the infrastructure portion of the budget.

James Webb Wilson, 300 South Street, suggested that the Town should consider what the Governor will do with Education funds.

No other residents wished to speak and the Public Hearing was closed at 7:25 p.m.

PRESENTATION:

Mayor Ellen L. Marmer, M.D. presented the 2007-2008 Budget overview to the Town Council prior to beginning of deliberations.

Council Member Etre, seconded by Council Member Apel, moved TO AMEND THE MOTION TO READ: THE TOWN COUNCIL MOVES TO SUSPEND ROBERTS RULES OF ORDER AND EACH TAB OF PAGE OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2007-2008 ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET BE OPENED; CLOSURE SHALL BE AT THE END OF FINAL DELIBERATIONS.
