WHAT TO DO IF YOU SEE A DOG PARKED IN A VEHICLE

Under the cruelty law (53-247a) it is not unlawful to keep your dog in a parked vehicle while the dog owner runs an errand. What is unlawful is the exposure to the elements the dog has to endure while the owner is away, such as days of high heat and high humidity.
