| 1. | Per the RFP, Section 11 on page 4: As this is not a construction project, will a bid bond be a mandatory requirement at time of proposal submission? | Yes |
| 2. | How many of your current vehicles will need hardware removed? | Currently, we do not have any equipment/hardware that needs to be removed from any of the vehicles. |
| 3. | In regards to the spares for both the BWC and ICV are you requesting an outright purchase of those items without any storage costs to just keep on hand? | The spare cameras would be on hand to replace any camera that is out of service that are damaged and/or cameras sent for repair |
| 4. | If so, are you requesting it include any additional warranty for those spares and to what extent? | Yes, we would want the same warranty coverage for those spare cameras. |
| 5. | What timeframe is Vernon PD expecting for the delivery and installation of the proposed products and services? | Delivery and installation would depend on the fund source timeline. |
| 6. | Would Vernon PD accept any deviation to the requested 90-day implementation schedule? | Yes, we would accept a deviation from the requested 90-day schedule as long as the Town and the bidder worked together to move the project forward at a reasonable pace. |
| 7. | Does the Vernon PD prefer mounting options that do not require permanent alteration to uniforms? | Yes, we would prefer not to permanently alter the uniforms. |
| 8. | BWC Question - Does Vernon PD require videos from officers on the same scene to automatically associate with one another based on proximity without any manual intervention? | No, but the Town would be interested in the feature. |
| 9. | VMC Question - Does Vernon PD require videos from vehicles on the same scene to automatically associate with one another based on proximity without any manual intervention? | No, but the Town would be interested in the feature. |
